The tournament trail will keep a running point total for each team registered and pay out after our final tournament on Androscoggin River October 3rd. There will be a one time fee of \$125 to fish the trail. All opens will remain at \$125 entry fee.

All tournaments will have a 7 fish limit with 12" minimum length. Standard tournament rules apply for all TBF tournaments. Rules will be covered at the tournament meeting before each event.



TBF 2010 TOURNAMENT TRAIL RULES

1. 6 TBF open tournaments will be held. These 6 tournaments will constitute our TBF trail. Teams can fish these 6 tournaments as opens only or as the trail also for an additional \$100 one time fee payable at the first tournament you fish.
2. The trail will be a team concept, **1 alternate per person 1 time only**.
3. From the 6 tournaments 1 will be a throw-out, the top 5 will be totaled for final standings including lunker points.
4. Points will be awarded from 100 on down with increments of 2 points down to the fifth position. 6th on down will be increments of one. Example: 1st 100 pts, 2nd 98 pts, 3rd 96 pts, 4th 94 pts, 5th 92 pts, 6th 91 pts, 7th 90 pts, 8th 89 pts, etc.
5. Lunker will be split 2 points each (Smallmouth/Largemouth). These points will be added to the total points a team accumulates for their finishing position. Example: 4th place with 1 lunker will receive 94 pts for 4th place and 2 pts for lunker for a total of 96 pts.
6. All TBF tournament rules will apply in conjunction with tournament trail.
7. All monies & prizes will be awarded at the Androscoggin River tournament held the 3rd of October.
8. Any team disqualified from an open tournament for rules infractions will receive 0 trail points for that tournament. If a team is disqualified, that tournament can be used as your 1 throw-out tournament.
9. All teams that “zero” or do not weigh in will receive 2 points less than the last team weighing in.
